On November 2017 I saw an ENT doctor for what I thought was a throat infection. The doctor checked my throat and said I had a lesion on my tongue. I did not know what that was. Then he said that word I never expected, cancer. When you hear that, everything just stops -- you hear nothing -- you just replay that word in your head. The day before Thanksgiving I found out it was stage 4. I did not think I had a long life ahead of me after hearing that. December 6th was my first Radiation appointment. The Payson Center staff was amazing and made me feel comfortable. Well 35 radiation treatments and 2 chemotherapy treatments later, I survived. It was the hardest thing I had ever been through. I could not have made it through it without my family and their support, especially my lovely wife Jane who drove me to and from every appointment. As of May 6th I have been cancer free 2 years.
