Cancer has not taken a break during the COVID-19 pandemic, so Payson Center is asking supporters to “Go the Social Distance” for its HOPE Resource Center in **Rock ‘N Race 2020 : 6FT to 5K**.

This year, instead of thousands gathering at the Statehouse to walk or run 5K through the streets of the capital city, participants will raise critical funds throughout the month of June, at their own pace and on their own course.
